INVITATION TO PARISH MINISTRIES

Altar Servers

Boys and girls grade three and up, serve the Church by actively participating in our weekend and special liturgies. Training sessions are ongoing during the year. The group also participates in special events through the year such as socials, seminars & fun activities.

Youth Ministry

It is a **youth** group in a parish who involve and engage with young people in the church or who live in their community.

Readers & Commentators

Are men and women who read the word of God, lead the Prayers of the Faithful and announce notices before Mass starts.

Extraordinary Ministers of Communion

Distribute Holy Communion during Mass, coming forward from the assembly (unvested) immediately following the sign of peace. Each minister serves regularly at a Mass of their choice.

Visiting the Homebound Parishioners

These are once-active church members who now have limitations that have reduced their involvement in the church. The visionary church may think of them and say, "If our homebound members are unable to come to church, let's take the church to them." One way of taking church to the homebound is through volunteer visitors who deliver both Communion and community to those who are confined to their homes.

Music Ministry (Adult & Children)

Music ministers are actively involved in our Sunday celebrations, liturgical celebrations, prayer vigils, and our parish Advent and Lenten Celebrations. We always welcome competent accompanists and dedicated singers.

Adult Servers

Lay persons serve the assembly at the altar and in the distribution of the Eucharist on special occasions and funerals.

Audio Visual (AV) Technicians

Audio Visual (AV) and Sound Technicians are required for Masses and special celebrations. They set up sound equipment, operate and monitor all audio and visual projection. Training is provided.

Catechists

Adults who are trained and are willing to be trained to teach catechism for

Children's Liturgy during Sunday Masses First Communion Classes Confirmation Classes RCIA and Baptism Preparation Sessions.

Ministers of Hospitality/Ushers

Ministers of Hospitality welcome those arriving for Mass and assist with finding seats. They also assist with emergencies, take up the collection, direct the flow for Communion and distribute the bulletins at the end of Mass. Occasionally ushers are required for large funerals and special functions.

Sacristans

These are the people who do the behind the scenes preparation for Liturgical celebrations. The vestments, and everything related to Mass are cleaned and readied.

Decorating Committee
