# Some thoughts on today's scripture



Today's feast is telling us that for God there are no foreigners, no outsiders. From his point of view, all are equally beloved children. We all,

È lo Spirito che scenderà un giorno sugli apostoli perché fecondino la terra e le diano vita eterna(At 2,4). E, pur avendo avuto un altro battesimo, altrimenti efficace (Mc 10,39), anche noi siamo stati battezzati "nel nome del Padre e del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo" (Mt 28,19). E, secondo la promessa, la Santa e Divina Trinità pone in noi la sua dimora (Gv 14,23). Essa trasforma la nostra vita, affidandola a Dio e attirandoci verso di lui con la forza di attrazione della risurrezione.

## Celebration of Marriage Mass with Bishop Nguyen - February 12, 2023 at 2:30 p.m.


