Some thoughts on today's scripture



John knew that his role was to bring people to Christ. So is ours. We try to live our lives right so that people will be able to know through us that faith in Christ makes all the difference.

John knew that his

baptism was preparatory; it was only 'with water'. Jesus baptised each of us with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit dwells in us; he leads and guides us; we try to be open to his powerful work in our hearts.

How does John help me to introduce Jesus in the wilderness of this time? He reminds me that I am called to be a witness to the true Light - Jesus. I ask the Lord to strengthen that sense of mission in my life and give me the grace to live it.
