Feast of the Holy Family

Some thoughts on today's scripture



These verses tell us much about Jesus' family. He was born under the Jewish Law, and observed it. After eight days he was circumcised, the sign of the Covenant

with God. Forty days after birth, his mother underwent purification in the Temple, and gave the offering -- a lamb for rich people, two pigeons for the poor.

Lord God, I often resent the law, and I often resent poverty. But I do not aim to be a law unto myself. I love your covenant. And poverty pinches less when it is shared with Jesus.

The Holy Spirit 'rested on' Simeon. Is my heart at peace and open, or am I so full of problems and requests that I have no resting space for the Spirit?

Ancora oggi Maria continua a soffrire con noi quando pone il suo sguardo sulle nostre pene e sulle nostre sofferenze, continua a soffrire con noi che rischiamo, coi nostri peccati, di perderci.

È raro vedere un ritratto o una statua della Madonna sorridente, mentre quasi in ogni chiesa vediamo rappresentata Maria addolorata.




Celebration of Marriage Mass with Archbishop Francis Leo February 11, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.
