Praying gently and with the imagination is a way of 'seeing' Jesus. Who is he for you? What is your favourite name for him, as they liked the name 'Rabbi/Teacher'? Prayer asks for this knowledge like in St Ignatius' prayer: 'Lord, teach me


Celebration of Marriage Mass with Archbishop Francis Leo February 11, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.
