Some thoughts on today's scripture



'Come, follow me'. The ways of following Jesus are as varied as people themselves are. But they always entail breaking free from what one was

before. We are true disciples when we challenge ourselves with the question: 'How would Jesus act in the situation I'm in right now?'

Lord Jesus, you are our life itself, pointing to what we can become and calling out all our power of service and devotion. We leave the frailty that is in us open to your touch. We commit the joy and the brokenness of our life to you.

There are Kingdom people everywhere, that is, people who base their lives on love and justice, on peace and freedom, who belong to many faiths. They are Kingdom people because their lives reflect the spirit of God.

In this gospel we see metanoia, that radical change of life, taking place. These men follow Jesus with total trust. They have no idea where they are going but believe and trust Jesus. We may not be called to the same journey, but are invited to trust in Jesus a little more in our daily life.

Ci sono due indicativi teologici che sono la ragione dei due successivi imperativi antropologici: è suonata l'ora messianica, l'attesa è finita poiché il regno di Dio si è fatto vicino, è ormai presente nella storia, perciò non è più possibile rimandare la decisione, occorre convertirsi, cambiare cioè la testa e la direzione del cammino passando a credere al vangelo.



The call of the disciples is so familiar to us that we tend to miss the wonder of the disciples' response, which was immediate and complete; they leave everything and follow Jesus. Can we do less if we feel that God is calling us to
