MUTATIS MUTANDI

When I was a child, I loved to play outside, in the yard or even on the street or parks with my neighbor friends. Sometimes, for some reason, I had to play alone and my favourite distraction was to pretend that I was a scientist, collecting different types of seeds, leaves, stones or only observing nature. I loved to give form to the clouds, imagining them as an animal, an object or vehicles. One time, I started to observe the butterflies and I was amazed by the mutation that they go through in order to become as they are. There is a slow process of changing, which bring them to a splendour of beauty. Their process of mutation, however, seemed to me to be difficult, as it could be for babies to walk or birds to fly.
