www.archtoronto.org/marriage. Reserved seating is limited, so please register early. All other seating is on a first-come, first served basis.

## SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ✓ Offerings for: Mass intentions, Sacraments (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, Wedding, Annoiting of sick) or funeral services don't go on tax receipts.
- ✓ Although mass intentions may be booked by phone, the offering for it should be brought in on the day of the mass or later, if necessary.
- ✓ The minimum donation requested for mass intentions is \$20 per intention.



- ✓ Children attending Catholic school do not automatically qualify to receive Baptism. Children are baptized Catholic if their parents are Catholic. Non-Catholic parents cannot have their children Baptized in the Catholic Church.
- ✓ All regular attendees of the parish are considered parishioners. It is recommended to be formally registered for record-keeping.
- ✓ If you have a love one in the hospital and you want them to receive a blessing and/or annointing of the sick, ask the lead nurse to call the Hospital Chaplain. If the Hospital Chaplain is not available, then you can call the parish. All hospitals have a priest designated/in charge to visit the sick.
