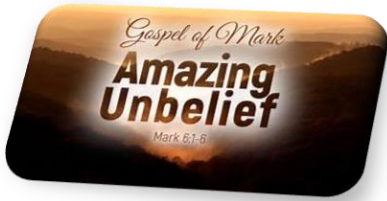

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Some thoughts on today's scripture



Jesus returns to his hometown of Nazareth only to be met with scepticism in spite of all the miracles he has performed. It is both Jesus' wisdom and his mighty works

that puzzle his relatives and the people of his home town. People couldn't accept the ordinariness of Jesus - that he grew up in a normal family which was named and well-known in Nazareth. Sometimes we find it hard to see the grace of God near to us, under our noses as it were. In the ordinariness of life and of love, of misunderstanding and hurt, of care and compassion, the grace of God and the love of God are active and alive.

Opposition never stopped Jesus. Even when they resisted his message and gave out about his family, he went ahead, going to other small villages, the wandering teacher. His message possessed him.

The wisdom of Jesus came from heaven and earth. He had a calm way of seeing the meaning in things and events. This was born of earth and of his divine origin in heaven.

Lord, there are depths in each of us, even those we think we know well, that only you can glimpse. A put-down tells more about the speaker than about the victim. Save me, Lord, from such folly.

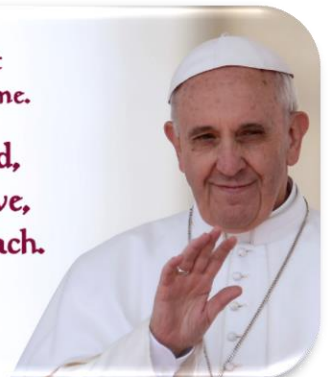
