## WEDDING IN 2026

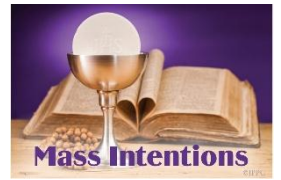


Dear couples planning to marry in 2026, if you want to marry in our church, please schedule an appointment with the pastor. So we may begin to work on your marriage process.

## FIRST MILLENNIAL SAINT



Pope Leo XIV on Friday set Sept. 7 as the rescheduled date to canonize the Catholic Church's first millennial-era saint Carlo Acutis. Acutis was 15 when he died in northern Italy in 2006, after a short bout with leukemia. He has become enormously popular, especially among young Catholics who have been flocking to his tomb in Assisi. In setting the Sept. 7 date, Leo announced that Acutis would be canonized along with another Italian Catholic, Pier Giorgio Frassati, who also died young at age 24 after contracting polio.
