Baptisms are held on most Saturdays of the month at 2 pm. For more information, please contact the office or visit our website.


MARRIAGE

Some thoughts on today's scripture



Jesus let go everything in becoming human. No one in his village or family really knew him for what he was. He ignored the

hope of his disciples that he would be a king. He emptied himself on the Cross. What do I need to be emptied of in order to be fully available to God? Word made flesh; you call us to break free from stifling self-centeredness and to find true freedom before you, no matter what it costs.

Lord, you ask me to take risks as you did. This is not a comfortable prayer, as I think about what you have in store for me. Give me courage.

Jesus does not put limits on belonging, instead his embrace is prepared to take in all who do God's will. I ask God to help me to broaden my horizons, not to let me be limited by a narrow scope of what is comfortable.

Church maintenance refers to the upkeep of all property and equipment that belongs to a


