

TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Some thoughts on today's scripture



Even in the presence of Jesus, with the memory of his words fresh in their minds, the disciples doubted. Like them, I bring my doubts and questions to Jesus and listen for his answer.

They were asking a question which they would ask again,

'Who is this man?' Being obeyed by wind and sea is a statement about being more than human. Our involvement with Jesus and our engagement with him in our lives will often bring that question to the fore. In prayer we grow in heart-knowledge of Jesus, not always being able to put words on our faith in him. Like the apostles, we know that he is a mystery - at once Son of God and son of the earth. In the trials and troubles of life, Jesus often seems to be asleep, heedless of my plight. In prayer, I will call out to him and, no doubt, I will hear his voice saying, "Peace! Be still! Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?"

God does not solve our problems but gives us the grace and the strength we need to resolve them.

Si tratta di un invito alla Pasqua che è un "passaggio": passaggio del mar Rosso per il popolo eletto, liberato dalla schiavitù e condotto alla libertà; passaggio dalla morte per il Figlio dell'uomo liberato dal peccato e condotto alla gloria. L'altra riva è la riva di Dio, la riva che non si vede e di cui Gesù rivela il cammino (Gv 14,4). La barca che attraversa il lago con i discepoli e Gesù è la Chiesa. Come l'arca di Noè, essa è stata costruita appositamente per "passare". Ma scoppia una tempesta. Le forze del male si scatenano contro di essa. La barca si riempie d'acqua, qui simbolo di morte: l'acqua toglie il respiro all'uomo.
