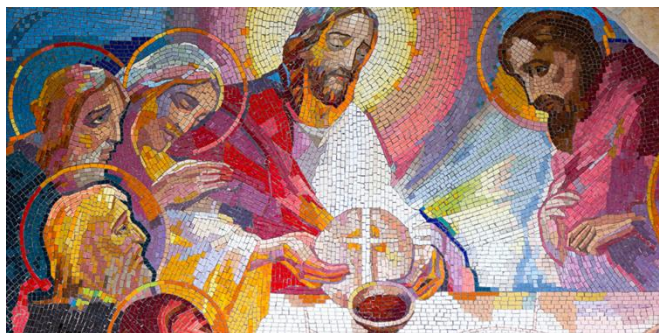

**NEW ENCYCLICAL RELEASED BY POPE LEO XIV: MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS**

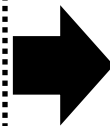
