THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Some thoughts on today's scripture



What was it that roused Jesus? fury? Not just that money changed hands and animals were sold for sacrifice in the Temple; but the

fact that the merchants were selling animals at a far higher price in the Temple than would be paid outside, and changing money at a rate that brought undue profit to the money-changers. The hucksters and money-changers were profiteering from people's piety, exercising a kind of monopoly that batted on the good will of the worshippers. Trade had taken over from prayer.

Our prayer today might remember all who suffer and are endangered in their commitment to justice and right to religion.

All'epoca ciò dovette sembrare quasi blasfemo. Si trova in seguito questo commento: "Molti credettero nel suo nome. Gesù però non si confidava con loro, perché conosceva tutti". Noi dobbiamo sempre provare il bisogno di fare penitenza, di conoscerci come Dio ci conosce.

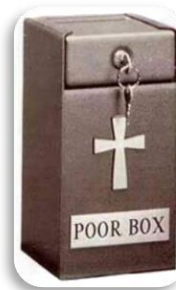
Many young women who are unexpectedly pregnant don't know where to turn for help. Through your support for ShareLife, our
