Fifth Week of Lent 2026 – Lazarus

“Four days. That’s how long Lazarus had been in the tomb when Jesus arrived. Not one day, not two – four. Long enough that Martha, practical and grief-worn, felt the need to warn Him: “Lord, by this time there will be an odor.” She was right, of course. By every human measure, it was too late. Jesus wept anyway. And then He called him out.

The fifth week of Lent does not ask you to tidy up what is dying in you before bringing it to God. It asks you to bring it exactly as it is – four days gone, wrapped in burial cloths, already mourned – and trust that the same voice that called Lazarus out of the tomb is calling you.”
