In 2024 your donations totaled \$43,436.05 and enabled our 18 members to assist 122 households through 355 home visits, providing grocery gift cards and mattresses for those in need. We enrolled 29 neighborhood children in the fully subsidized summer camps Marygrove and Ozanam and our Bundle Up weekends were very successful. At Christmas, we helped 91 families with grocery cards, and provided 56 children with toys through the Firefighters' Toy Drive and 27 teens with gift cards. We provided winter coats for 9 people. We have also provided donated groceries to many families. You can see the full message on the announcement board.
