Please **contact the office at least one year in advance**. Weddings are held at 12 pm on most Saturdays of the month.


#### HOMEBOUND MINISTRY

## HABEMUS PAPAM Cardinal Louis Marius Prevost (Sept 14, 1955)



Born in Chicago, Illinois, USA, the new elected Pope Leo XIV is the first North America Pope. A member of the Augustinian order, he has a guite resume, performing his ministry in different countries, positions and responsibilities. He studied at the Minor Seminar of the Augustinian Fathers and after he studied at Villanova University. Pope Leo XIV professed his solemn vows as Augustinian in 1981. He received his Theological education at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago, then went to Rome to specialize in Canon Law at the Angelicum University. In Rome, he was ordained priest in 1982 and became a pro-president of the Secretariat for Non-Christians, known today the Dicastery for interreligious Dialogue. By the time, he was preparing his doctoral thesis at in Rome, he was sent in mission to Chulucanas in Peru. Later, after concluding his PhD, he was appointed vocation and mission director of his province of Mother of Good Counsel in Illinois -USA.

#### **Missionary in Peru**

The new Pontiff was transferred to Trujillo in Peru. From 1988 to 1992, he was the superior of the community, 1988 - 1998 formation director, 1992-1998 instructor for the professed Members, 1989-1998 judicial vicar for Archdiocese of Trujillo and professor of Canon Law, Patristics, Moral Theology. Also, during this time, he was performing pastoral service at the new parish Saint Rita located in a poor suburb of the city and then as parish administrator of Our Lady of Monserrat from 1992 to 1999.

## Back to Chicago

In 1999 he was sent back to Chicago to be the Provincial Prior (Superior of the Congregation).

## Rome

About 3 years later, Prevost was elected Superior of the entire Order of Saint Augustine (Prior General) and moved to Rome. He was re-elected in 2007 for a second term until 2013, when he returned to Chicago. There, he was serving as director of formation for new students, First Councilor and Provincia vicar.

## **Bishop in Peru**

On November 03, 2014, Pope Francis appointed him as Apostolic Administrator of the Peruvian Diocese of Chiclayo, ordaining him as bishop of Sufar. On the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, in the Cathedral of Saint Mary he received the third degree of the presence of the Holy Spirit, by being ordained as bishop. The new Pontiff Leo XIV, exercise the ministry as bishop in Peru in Chiclayo from 2015 to 2023.

## Called to Rome

On January 30, 2023, the new Pontiff was called to Rome as new Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and President of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America, promoting him to the rank of Archbishop, replacing the Canadian Cardinal Quellet. Archbishop Prevost was elevated to Cardinal by Pope Francis in September 30, 2024 and assigned him the Diaconate of Saint Monica. Once in Rome, Pope Francis appointed him as member of different Dicasteries and Congregations. He was also present in the last Apostolic journeys of Pope Francis.

#### **Election as Pope**

On May 08, 2025, on the Feast Day of Our Lady of Pompei, Cardinal Prevost was elected Pope with the name of Leo XIV, after Leo XIII, who had deep concern about the Social Doctrine of the Church. Sources: <u>www.vatican.va</u> & Augustinian Order.
