

Some thoughts on today's scripture



Lord, you terrify me with this command: "Go and teach all nations." You were talking to eleven men, without education, money influence, in a despised province of the Roman

Empire. But they obeyed you, because they knew you were with them. And today Christians are the largest body of believers on this planet. Today's preaching is different. We are educated, sometimes too well. It is harder than ever to make our voice heard.

A man went out on a starry night and shook his fist at the heavens yelling, "Oh, God, what a lousy, rotten world you've made. I could have done much better." Then a voice boomed from the clouds saying, "That's why I put you there. Get busy." The Ascension is the time when Jesus puts us in charge of his mission and of his work, promising to be always with us. Prayer can be a time of asking and discovering where each of us can work in this world.


