EUCHARIST: THE WAY TO HOLINESS



This weekend in Rome, a canonization ceremony will take place for a young boy named Carlo Acutis. Carlo lived a life like that of any other teenager or millennial of his time. He was a living person full of energy and love for God. His parents were not 'good Catholics' in the sense that they were not practicing their faith, coming to Church. However, Carlo was so connected to God that he was able to attract people to faith. Carlo's mother said in an interview: "Carlo

for me was not only a son, but also a father because he was full of high wisdom - he was always teaching me new things".

One of Carlo's most common thoughts was: "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven." He couldn't stay away from Mass for a long time. Today, we celebrate our Patron Saint, St. Norbert, and look at Carlo's life. We remember that our most important call is to become Saints. We become saints as we become more and more like Jesus.

This weekend, we welcome six new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. They will distribute Jesus to us during the masses and bring Holy Communion to the sick and seniors in their homes. We embrace this new year with all the challenges and graces that are to come, and we thank God for being in His presence and in His Church.

CANONIZATION OF BL. CARLO ACUTIS & BL. GIORGIO FRASSATI



On September 7, the Church canonized Carlo Acutis, the first Millennial saint and "Cyber Apostle of the Eucharist", alongside Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, known as "The Man of the Beatitudes." Two young men from different eras who led completely different lives, but who are nonetheless united in their love for Christ and their ability to impart that love to those

whose lives they touched.

According to the Archdiocese of Toronto, all couples must contact their parish at least a year before their wedding because marriage in the Church is a sacred sacrament.




DISCERNMENT WEEKEND RETREAT -
